Soccer club is doing some very good things. Considered in the top tear of Rush clubs based on cohesiveness, direction, community involvement and progress. "Oregon Rush was hardly a club a half dozen years ago. Now they are a formidable opponent," says Tim Schulz, President & C.E.O. of Rush Soccer. Oregon Rush has grown from 200 to nearly 1000 players during its four year association with Rush Soccer, and elevated its level of success on the state, regional and national level. In 2010, three Oregon Rush players were invited to National team Camps, and another 6 participated at Region IV camps. They are adding a WPSL team to their women's program in 2011, and hope to add a PDL program to their boys side by 2016.
