Leading the way is Mallory Weber (pictured) from [Michigan Rush](#) who is ranked No. 4 in the country. The Penn State Forward has scored 8 goals and added 2 assists for the 12-2-0 Nittany Lions. Weber was named Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Week (with [Colorado Rush](#) alum Hannah Clark of Iowa) for scoring 2 goals against Indiana over the weekend. The Freshman of the week honor marks the third so far this fall for Weber.
