

This past weekend the U14 Boys Select

ID Camp took place in Casa Grande, Arizona. 28 players from several states and 3 players from Bahamas Rush were joined by three coaches for a weekend long training camp to identify the top players in Rush Nation for the U14 Boys Select Team.
